

What does it take to achieve WEFE Nexus?





All of the above are considered WEFE Nexus but true Nexus requires more

WEFE Nexus requires synergies and tradeoffs



Synergies are positive interactions across WEFE sectors goals to ensure all goals are moving in the same direction and working together



Trade-offs can advance a specific sector goal but may negatively affect the possibility of achieving another sector goal




WEFE Nexus requires synergies and tradeoffs

Within the existing policy framework in Jordan Synergies can and are being recognized and optimized but tradeoff between sectors faces high resistance due to:


- Sector specific polices
- Sector specific KPIs
- Sector specific services
- Sector specific budgets







WEFE Nexus may require trade offs between sectors





WEFE Nexus may require Changes in the scope of work of ministries

Breaking the silos ------ Changes in the scope of work of ministries which **must** be initiated by regulatory changes

- Existing regulatory framework clearly identifies roles and responsibilities and creates a clear line between the miniseries in order for each ministry to be responsible and liable for their scope.
- Some changes maybe required to move the lines of responsibilities in some specific WEFE nexus areas in order to have some roles and responsibilities become joint responsibilities between two ministries.



WEFE Nexus may require trade offs between sectors

To have tradeoffs, joints goals and KPIs and budgets are necessary.

Cross cutting policy for WEFE Sectors

Jordan's Economic Modernization Vision's Implementation Plan mentions the WEFE NEXUS as an initiative which aims to maximize cohesive environmentally friendly and climate-adaptive outputs and sustainable growth

Jordan 2025: A National Vision and Strategy mentions the concept of green economy in key sectors including energy, transport, water, waste, agriculture, and tourism.

Jordan Green Growth National Plan 2021-2025 The plan covers all WEFE NEXUS issues in relation to the environment and green growth, relating to the energy, transport, water, waste, agriculture, and tourism sectors

Conclusions about existing WEFE Nexus policy framework

- Most exiting regulatory documents will have a coordination clause with other sectors.
- There are several sectorial attempts to advance WEFE Nexus but all issued regulatory documents are still issued by a specific sector.
- The concept of joint management between sectors is still to be explored.

Paradigm shift: is an important change that happens when the usual way of thinking about or doing something is replaced by a new and different way





What tools / steps can be used

Evaluation of existing strategies and policies- to learn from previous interventions with focus on synergies and trade-offs

Develop Cross-sectoral strategies and policies - to reinforce cross-cutting objectives, goals, and responsibilities for multiple WEFE sectors

Integrating units – Cross sectorial units can be integrated to facilitate achieving joint objectives including services and projects

Action plans – to advance strategic goals set in sectoral and cross sectoral strategies, by unfolding detailed implementation pathways to achieve them

Knowledge exchange - between experts and practitioners to advance the policy integration efforts
